Dear Parishioner...Around & About Ste. Rose,

Governor Baker announces the gradual lifting of COIVD restrictions

It has been fourteen months since Governor Baker placed restrictions due to the pandemic of COVD 19. The media has done a superb job in keeping the public upto-date as these restrictions which are in the process of being lifted. The Diocese of Springfield continually updates the parishes as to what can and cannot be practiced

at Sunday Mass. This bulletin column will continue to publish the updated protocols for the celebration of all liturgical events in the life of the parish: Nuptial Masses, Liturgies of Christian Burial, Baptisms, School Masses, and Sunday Mass. As our society begins to embrace "a new and better normal" it is important to maintain the wearing of "facial masks" in larger public gatherings – at least for the time being. Please continue to wear a facial covering properly, that is, the mask must cover both mouth and nose. When approaching for the reception of Holy Communion, please keep the facial mask on your face until the Eucharist has been placed in your hand. Then proceed to remove the mask partially, consume the Eucharist, and replace the mask to full covering.

<u>Communion in the Hand</u> While there are some Catholics who may prefer to receive the Eucharist on their tongues, please continue to receive in your hands. At a later date, when it is safer to receive on the tongue, it will become an option again. However, for the safety of all congregants, communicants who prefer to receive on the tongue would need to be the last persons to receive the Eucharist. It is so easy for the priest, deacon, or minister of the Eucharist to accidentally touch the tongue. Should that occur, the distributor of the Eucharist MUST stop distributing the Eucharist and re-sanitize their hands before administering the Eucharist to the next person. For the time-being, please continue to receive the Eucharist in the hand.

The Role of the Laity at Sunday Mass

The role of the laity at the celebration of the Eucharist is significant! Lectors, Ministers of the Eucharist, Altar Servers, and Greeters/Ushers, all play an important part of each Mass. With the relaxed protocols each of these ministries are now allowed to be fulfilled. The new protocol allows as many as six persons to be part of the choir. If individuals feel comfortable enough to return to fulfill these roles, please do so.

A New and Better Normal

A new and better normal period of adjustment is about to become part of our collective experience. Ste. Rose de Lima parish needs to recruit more volunteers to service all aspects of liturgical life. We need volunteers for the following roles/ministries:

- +Lectors
- +Special Ministers of the Eucharist
- +Greeters/Ushers
- +Altar servers both youth and adults for funerals
- +Choir members

Over the years the number of volunteers has dwindled in most, if not all, of the above-mentioned liturgical roles. It is time for the "rank and file" of the parish to step up to the plate and participate more fully in the liturgical life of the parish. The parish is requesting a little bit more of your time to assist at the Mass you normally attend. It is not enough to simply attend Mass; it is important to assist at Mass in a role in which you feel most comfortable. As we begin the phase of "a new and better normal" please consider how you can make a difference by participating more fully in the celebration of the Eucharist at Sunday Mass – you'll be glad you did!
