Getting to a "new normal!"

Ste. Rose de Lima Parish has been most cautious in following the mandated protocol for worshipping safely during this time of pandemic. The most efficient way to achieve a new normal is for everyone to get vaccinated. The sooner the general population is vaccinated, the sooner the protocol regime will be lifted – how welcoming that will be! Beginning Pentecost Sunday, the entrance procession and the recessional procession will return. At the conclusion of each liturgy, please be respectful of the social limits of not touching the priest or deacon – we still need to keep that protocol. The parish/diocese will lift restrictions as does the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. As of this writing, Springfield and Chicopee are among several communities that are in “the red zone” with the number of coronavirus infections. Let us be mindful of that fact. The wearing of a facial mask is still required to enter the church building. Please wear a facial covering while in church, except for the reception of The Eucharist. The parish needs to recruit a few more volunteers to assist with the disinfection of the church after each liturgy. It only takes a few minutes of your time to help disinfect. Soon, that protocol will be eliminated too.

The Reception of Holy Communion

For those members of the parish who prefer to receive communion “on the tongue,” that practice will return on Pentecost Sunday. However, to assure the safety of all congregants, please be among the last persons to receive holy communion. The

reason is simple: should the person who is distributing holy communion touch your tongue ever so slightly, he/she must stop distributing holy communion and disinfect their hands. Please follow this process without exception.

And finally,

We have experienced an unprecedented pandemic and are beginning to emerge from it. Each of us needs to be mindful of so many persons who have died, either directly or indirectly from COVID 19. I have made every attempt to gently guide us through this painful experience. I have needed to keep myself safe to be available for the needs of the entire parish. Obviously, there have been many restrictions on my time and availability. The diocese placed restrictions on what could and could not be done by the few clergyman of the diocese. If I have disappointed anyone during this pandemic, I seek your pardon. The life of the parish “ceased” as we knew it. The staff had limits, volunteers could no longer be of service, rectory staff was safe at home; however, the parish continued to meet the salaries of all employees. As we begin to emerge from the pandemic, it is my hope and prayer that we find a new and better normal for parish life. The parish needs to expand its ministries and outreach. Please consider how you can make St. Rose a better parish and worshipping community. When many people work together for the betterment of the parish the burden is made lighter. Consider how you can contribute to the well-being of the parish with true stewardship, that is, sharing your TIME, TALENT, and TREASURE. With much love and admiration,
