**An Update concerning the Delta Variant of COVID 19**

The Archdiocese of Boston has announced the following information regarding recommendations for the wearing of facial masks in conjunction with the CDC:

**Effective July 30:** The Department of Public Health has issued a new mask advisory considering the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's updated guidance. Fully vaccinated individuals are advised to wear a mask or face covering when indoors (and not in your own home) if you have a weakened immune system, or if you are at increased risk for severe disease because of your age or an underlying medical condition, or if someone in your household has a weakened immune system, is at increased risk for severe disease, or is an unvaccinated adult. Masks are still mandatory for all individuals on public and private transportation systems (including rideshares, livery, taxi, ferries, MBTA, Commuter Rail and transportation stations), in healthcare facilities and in other settings hosting vulnerable populations, such as congregate care settings. **What does this mean for Ste. Rose de Lima Parish?**

The delta variant is more contagious than the original COVID 19. If fully vaccinated, there is the chance of becoming infected with the delta variant; however, the impact on one's health could be minimal. That tends to be the case so far around the country. If there are any underlying health issues, one could be more vulnerable to the delta variant. If unvaccinated, the risk of being infected with serious health issues with possible hospitalization is greatly increased. With that said, should any parishioner prefer to wear a mask at Mass please feel free to do so. There are several members who prefer to wear a mask during Mass! Please use good judgment as to whether you choose to wear facial coverings. Let's all stay safe as the delta variant spreads throughout the country.

**9/11 Twentieth Year Remembrance Mass**

As the nation is facing uncertainty with the new wave of the delta variant, the 20<sup>th</sup> year Remembrance Mass is in the planning process. The Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, September 11, 2021 at 7:00 PM here at Ste. Rose de Lima. Should the CDC or the diocese change guidelines to contain the delta variant with new mandates concerning the number of people in public gathering spaces, that information will be forwarded to you via the bulletin. With the uncertainty that our nation faces, the reception normally associated with the 9/11 Mass is "on hold" for now. More information will be forthcoming.
