Post COVID 19 Ministry at Ste. Rose

COVID 19 restrictions have been lifted. It is now time to re-engage all parish ministries that were restricted during the pandemic. The following are some of the ministries that need volunteers for service:

+ <u>**Religious Formation teachers**</u> for the religious education of the youth of the parish who attend Chicopee Public schools, both elementary and secondary years of education.

+ *Coffee & Donuts* for the social hour after the 9:00 AM Mass

+ <u>Sacristans</u> for the setup and clean-up of Mass on the weekends

+ <u>Bingo Volunteers</u> Though not necessarily a "ministry" volunteers assist the parish in meeting its financial obligation to SJA School. All proceeds from Bingo revenue are for the benefit of SJA. + <u>Community Life Commission</u> This very active commission is involved in many "outreach ministries" that benefit the greater Chicopee community as well as parish events such as "Warm hearts, Warming hands", the Parish Picnic – which will return in September of 2022, tag sales, winter coat collections for children, etc.

+ <u>Heartfelt Meals</u> A once a month, second Sunday of the month, morning ministry delivering fresh meals to homebound residents who normally receive Meals on Wheels Monday-Friday.

GLORIOUS MYSTERIES: 1. The Resurrection 2. The Ascension to Heaven 3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit 4. The Assumption of Mary 5. The Coronation of Mary.
