THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FOCUS: The law of the Lord delights the human heart and guides the steps of our lives. Today's Gospel opens with the words and intentions of Luke the Evangelist. He has decided to write a Gospel – a *narrative of the events* regarding Jesus Christ that will draw from the memories of those who witnessed his life, death, and resurrection, and who have handed on his teachings to future generations. We cling to that Gospel message, which reminds us of God's mercy and challenges us to live in Christ.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: Nehemiah, Ezra, and other instruct the people to rejoice and not be sad, for their God has made the day holy. St. Paul instructs the Corinthians, using the image of the body to describe the Church and explaining that each person has a role in it. In the Gospel, Jesus reads from the book of the prophet Isaiah in the synagogue in Nazareth and proclaims, *Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.*

COVID 19 testing

Lab 24 has invited Ste. Rose to be a free testing site for COVID 19 testing. Lab 24 will provide 25 test kits to begin with. Once 10 tests have been self-administered, the kits will be mailed, and a rapid result will be given. The parish needs one person to coordinate this program. The responsibility will be to maintain an accurate inventory, mail in minimally 10 self-administered kits, and re-order when necessary. Lab 24 will be happy to assist with any questions that may arise. Either let Father know as you leave Mass this weekend or call the Pastoral Center as soon as possible. The kits are already in the possession of the parish. We can begin as soon as someone is willing to coordinate this COVID 19 test program.

COVID 19 Guidelines

As of this writing, the City of Chicopee has not imposed a mask mandate except for entering of city buildings. The parish will not impose a mask mandate unless the mandate originates with the City of Chicopee. However, Mass attendees are free to either wear a mask or to not wear a mask. Ministers of the Eucharist are required by the diocese of wear masks for the distribution of the Eucharist. The hand sanitizing stations are still at all the entrances of the church. Feel free to sanitize your hands as you are comfortable. If you are either sick or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive, please stay home until the illness has passed or no longer test positive for COVID 19. Let's assist each other in keeping healthy.

DANCEATHON CANCELLED Due to the sharp rise in COVID, the Western Mass Charity DanceAthon is canceled for February 11-12 2022 and rescheduled for next year. In spite of the cancellation, two grants will be awarded this year from funds raised in anticipation of the 2022 WMCD. "Rick's Place" will receive a \$10,000 grant for grief support services for youth. "KEVS Foundation" will receive the second grant in the amount of \$2,000. Established in memory of 19-year-old Kevin Major, the foundation provides free sudden cardiac arrest testing for high school athletes as well as AED units for public places.
