**2022 Annual Catholic Appeal**

The 2022 ACA theme is “*Transformed in Christ.*” This annual appeal assists the diocese in not only supporting ministries within the diocese, including Catholic Schools, but also to agencies throughout Western Massachusetts that assist our sisters and brothers that need special services. One great service is offered by *Clearway* which is located adjacent to MGM downtown Springfield on Columbus Avenue. *Clearway* is a non-profit counseling center that encourages pregnant families to bring their pregnancy to full term versus choosing an abortion. This agency has literally saved hundreds of innocent lives from the abortion procedure. Your annual contribution makes a difference. **Pew Project Update**

The front left quarter section of pews has been shipped for refurbishing. While the pews are “away” the flooring will be scraped, washed, and waxed for an incredible finish that is not possible while the pews are in place. The same quarter of ceiling will be painted as well as the walls while the pews are away. As mentioned last weekend, the painting of the ceiling and walls will cost so much less without having the need to erect scaffolding throughout the church. Scaffolding of such size would have been minimally \$120,000. The ceiling will be painted for \$19,500 and the walls for \$12,500. The total to accomplish the painting of the church will be considerably less than just the scaffolding alone. The Stations of the Cross will be stored section by section and re-hung after the walls are painted and cured. The walls will be as close to the existing color as is possible. Light colored walls work very well with the brilliant colors of the stained glass. Each section is estimated to take 3-4 weeks. The church will be in continuous use throughout the project. This project ought to be a minimal inconvenience.

## CONSTRUCTION OF VETERANS' MEMORIAL PARK AT ST. ROSE CEMETERY

We are pleased to announce that Ste. Rose de Lima Parish is in the planning stages of erecting a Veterans' Memorial Park at the Ste. Rose Cemetery. This memorial will be constructed to honor all six branches of our military, past, present, and future; as well as those who are POW/MIA. At the center of the Veterans' Memorial there will be three monuments featuring inscribed bronze plaques that pay tribute to the men and women of the armed forces and provide our heartfelt thanks for their service and sacrifice. There will also be a flag walkway and a memorial brick walkway.

While this is an ambitious project, we believe it to be a worthwhile endeavor. You may be interested to know that there are presently 1,572 veterans buried in our cemetery including three from the Civil War. We are committed to ensuring this Veterans' Memorial will honor all our veterans, past and present while providing a quiet place for reflection and prayer.

There are two ways you can support this project:

1. Through a one-time donation in any amount.
2. The purchase of an engraved brick for a donation of \$100. The bricks will be used to construct the memorial walkway to the three monuments. The veteran to be honored does not need to be buried in the Ste. Rose Cemetery.

Our new Cemetery Committee has devoted time and resources to refurbishing and beautifying Ste. Rose Cemetery. To date, they have coordinated the repointing of the stone pillars at the main entrance, repair and repainting of the perimeter fence, the replacement and relocation of an unsightly container by securing new fencing and cutting and removal of several fallen trees and cleanup of leaves and debris.
