# Dear Parishioner...Around & About Ste. Rose, Renovation Updates

The renovations in the church are now winding down to the last one-quarter. This past week the painting of the ceiling was completed, the painting of the choir loft facing, and walls were started. Remember, the project needs to be closely scheduled around the hectic funeral schedule. As soon as the painting is finished the flooring company will refurbish that section of flooring. And, at last, the final section of pews will be reinstalled as well as the reupholstered kneeling pads attached to the kneelers. Many thanks to the volunteers who stripped the material off the old kneeling pads and pulled out the thousands of staples. The volunteers' efforts helped to significantly reduce the cost of updating the kneelers throughout the church. The estimated cost of a total replacement with new kneelers would have easily cost over \$50,000. The next phase is to stain and polyurethane all the pieces of the new book racks. There are approximately 400 book racks throughout the pews. Once assembled, the new book racks will be installed. Your cooperation throughout this process of renovation has been appreciated. The painting of the foyer of the church will be the next phase of the continuing renovations of our magnificent parish church.

### The Diocese of Springfield announces the October "pew count."

The diocese has an interest to learn how many Catholics are returning to Sunday Mass now that the COVID restrictions are gone and a process of returning to Sunday Mass seems to be taking place. The weekends are October 22-23; October 29-30; and November 5-6. For past pew counts, Ste. Rose has used a paper attendance ticket that was added to the Offering basket. The ushers will be asked to be sure that every person from infants to adults have an "attendance ticket" so that all persons will be counted. Your cooperation for this "pew count" will be appreciated. White ticket will be for "ADULTS" and a "COLOR" ticket for infants/children up to 12 years old.

#### Post COVID wake-up call!

Throughout society the post COVID challenge of re-engaging the spirit of volunteerism is confronting many organizations and non-profits. The same is true in the parish. There are opportunities to serve on the Parish Pastoral Council, ushers/greeters, adult/youth choir members, etc. The parish needs you to come forward and volunteer! "Many hands make light work" - as the saying goes. Please consider assisting the parish to "wake-up" from the slumber of COVID and make Ste. #### And finally,

You may be wondering, how the parish is affording the renovations? There have been no appeals for contributions! This current renovation project is being paid for by the dividends and interests from the Long-term Pooled Investments managed by the diocese. Not once has the principal amount been touched. COVID has had a serous effect upon the Sunday Offering, I must admit. Other money-saving budget cuts have helped somewhat: the housekeeper's position in the rectory was not filled with her retirement, the custodian's position was reduced to 20 hours versus fulltime with his retirement, and fewer secretarial hours in the Pastoral Center. Salaries are the biggest item on the parish budget. During this period of an 8.3% inflation rate, I have not pressed you for an increased offertory collection. Please support the parish spiritually and financially to the best of your ability. As I have begun my 18th year here at Ste. Rose, the parish has never used "financial reserves" for recurring expenditures. Your weekly/monthly/annual support has made that possible in the past and I pray that will continue. In effect "your" money is accomplishing great things as "we" continue to renovate and improve our magnificent campus. Believe me when I say that I am so appreciative of the trust you have placed in me for these many years. With much love and affection,
