Dear Parishioner...Around & About Ste. Rose, The Future of the remaining Catholic Parishes in Chicopee

Since the announcement of the closure of Holy Name of Jesus Parish effective June 30, 2023, there appears to be a concern among the parishioners about the future of the four remaining Chicopee parishes: St Anthony of Padua, St. Anne, St. Stanislaus Basilica, and of course, Ste. Rose de Lima. While I 'm unable to project the future, and don't know the strength of the three other parishes, I can say with assurance, that Ste. Rose de Lima Parish has a secure future. Together, we have addressed the many deficiencies of our campus that pre-existed upon my arrival as your pastor on July 1, 2005. Simply put, our campus is in very good repair and the finances of the parish have a good foundation. The crucial elements in determining the future viability of any parish are twofold: the continuing attendance of the membership at Sunday Mass and the continuing financial support of the membership.

While it's wonderful to experience "a bump" in attendance at Easter and Christmas, these two holydays by themselves are unable to sustain the spiritual and financial life of the parish throughout the remainder of the year. The theme of STEWARDSHIP: TIME, TALENT, AND TREASURE ought to be part of each member's responsibility. It's sad to say that too many members still contribute one dollar or so each week to the parish. The sum of \$52.00 annually does little or nothing to personal finances when it comes to our budgets. The monthly cable, cellphone, electric, and food budgets, home and auto insurance premiums far exceed the one-dollar threshold. Though our economy is experiencing inflation, it's fair to say that most adults can afford more than one dollar. If not, then one dollar is fine. In 1950, one dollar was a decent contribution. When a bottle of salad dressing is \$3.29, it's easy to deduct logically that the one dollar of the 1950's is not the one dollar of 2023.

For a parish to exist into the future the parish must be able to operate "in the black" from week to week. The moment the parish needs to dip into its reserves to pay recurring expenditures, it signals the beginning of the end of that parish. The reserves of the parish – its dividends and interest – have afforded over 90% of all expenses incurred for the re-building of our campus over the last nearly 18 years.

So, how does a parish "secure its future?" STEWARDSHIP: TIME, TALENT, AND TREASURE. Admittedly, in the nearly 18 years in my pastorate, week in and week out, the gospel has been preached. The membership cannot say the Sunday experience is always about money. In fact, the "money issue" has never been addressed. Consistently the parish has sought your time and talent more often than your treasure.

As you can see, the future of Ste. Rose de Lima as a parish is literally in your hands. Invite people to Sunday Mass, share your time and talent, and share a reasonable amount of your treasure. That's how "we will secure our future."
