I thank you for the many positive responses that I received from you after you read my bulletin column last weekend. The future viability of Ste. Rose de Lima Parish is "squarely" in your hands. STEWARDSHIP: TIME, TALENT, and TREASURE will be the measure by which the future of this parish will be determined.

Update on the sanctuary renovations

If all goes as hoped for, the sanctuary walls and ceiling will be painted, and the new "religious art" pieces ought to be in place by September of 2023. Two 8'x2' angels will be attached on either side of the crucifix and two 8'x 4' crosses (modeled after the original crosses painted on the side walls for the dedication in 1954) will adorn the two side walls of the sanctuary. On the left, in the cross beam will be depicted "The Lamb on the Seven Gold Seals", and on the right, "The Pelican feeding her chicks with her own blood." With these artistic additions, the sanctuary will take on a greater sense of being "sacred space." The upcoming renovations will mean that scaffolding will be erected in the sanctuary area and will not be removed until the religious art is placed. So, please be patient for this final stage of the church renovations. And, in the right alcove, where the baptismal font is located, a wall-mounted pedestal will be made to match the one on the left, thereby lifting the statue of the Sacred Heart to its rightful height.
